1 UNDERSTANDING RYBELSUS PRICING IN 2026

Rybelsus (semaglutide tablets) is the **first and only oral GLP-1 receptor agonist** approved by the FDA for the treatment of type 2 diabetes in adults. Unlike injectable Ozempic and Wegovy, Rybelsus is taken as a daily tablet, offering a needle-free alternative for patients who prefer oral medication. In December 2024, the FDA also approved the new **Rybelsus R2 formulation** with improved bioavailability, which may affect future pricing. Understanding the current cost landscape is essential to finding the most affordable path to treatment.

KEY DIFFERENCE: RYBELSUS vs OZEMPIC vs WEGOVY

All three contain semaglutide, but Rybelsus is the **ONLY** oral (tablet) form.

Rybelsus is FDA-approved for type 2 diabetes only — **NOT** for weight loss.

The oral form generally has lower bioavailability than injections, requiring daily dosing.

The new R2 formulation (approved Dec 2024) improves absorption and may reduce food restrictions.

2 NOVO NORDISK SAVINGS CARD FOR RYBELSUS

The Novo Nordisk Savings Card is the most impactful cost-reduction tool for commercially insured patients. It can reduce your out-of-pocket cost to as little as **\$10 per 30-day fill** for up to 24 months.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must have commercial (private) health insurance that covers Rybelsus

- Must NOT be enrolled in Medicare, Medicaid, TRICARE, or any federal/state program
- Must be a U.S. resident, 18 years or older
- Must have a valid prescription for Rybelsus

How to Activate:

- Step 1: Visit Rybelsus.com/savings or call 1-877-304-6855
- Step 2: Complete the online enrollment form
- Step 3: Receive your digital savings card instantly
- Step 4: Present the card at your pharmacy with your prescription

IMPORTANT NOTES

The Savings Card covers up to 24 monthly fills (2 years of treatment).
Maximum savings of \$150 per fill — you pay as little as \$10.
If your insurance copay is already below \$10, the card will not provide additional savings.
The card can be combined with your existing insurance benefits.

3 NOVOCARE DIRECT: CASH-PAY PROGRAM

For patients without insurance or whose insurance does not cover Rybelsus, the NovoCare Direct program offers a significant discount over the retail list price.

Program Details:

- Fixed price: **\$449 per 30-day supply (any dose: 3 mg, 7 mg, or 14 mg)**
- No insurance required — designed for cash-pay patients
- Prescription is filled through Novo Nordisk's partner pharmacy network
- Includes free home delivery

How to Enroll:

- Step 1: Call NovoCare at 1-888-809-3942
- Step 2: Provide your prescription information
- Step 3: Set up payment and delivery preferences
- Step 4: Receive Rybelsus delivered to your door

SAVINGS COMPARISON

Retail price: ~\$936–\$1,029/month | NovoCare Direct: \$449/month
Annual savings: approximately \$5,844–\$6,960 compared to retail price.
This is the best option for uninsured patients who do not qualify for the PAP.

4 PATIENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (PAP) — FREE RYBELSUS

Novo Nordisk offers a Patient Assistance Program that provides **Rybelsus at no cost** to qualifying patients who meet specific income and insurance criteria. This is the most valuable program for eligible patients.

Eligibility Criteria:

- U.S. citizen or legal resident**
- Household income at or below 400% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
2026 FPL 400%: ~\$62,400 single / ~\$129,600 family of 4
- Uninsured, OR insurance does not cover Rybelsus
- NOT enrolled in Medicare Part D, Medicaid, or other government programs
- Must have a valid prescription from a licensed U.S. healthcare provider

How to Apply:

- Step 1: Download the PAP application from NovoCare.com
- Step 2: Complete the application with your provider's help
- Step 3: Submit proof of income (tax return, pay stubs, or SSA letter)
- Step 4: If approved, receive Rybelsus shipped directly to your home at no cost
- Step 5: Reapply annually to maintain eligibility

PRO TIP

Processing typically takes 2–4 weeks. Ask your provider about samples or the NovoCare Direct program as a bridge while your PAP application is being reviewed.

5 MEDICARE PATIENTS: YOUR OPTIONS IN 2026

Rybelsus has a significant advantage for Medicare patients compared to Wegovy: because Rybelsus is approved for **type 2 diabetes** (not weight loss), it is covered under **Medicare Part D** as a standard diabetes medication. The Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) further benefits Medicare beneficiaries.

Key Medicare Benefits for Rybelsus:

- Rybelsus IS covered under Medicare Part D for type 2 diabetes**
- \$2,000 annual out-of-pocket cap (IRA provision, effective 2025)
This means your TOTAL annual drug costs are capped at \$2,000 — including Rybelsus
- \$0 monthly payment option available through Medicare Prescription Payment Plan
Spread your \$2,000 cap across 12 monthly payments of ~\$167/month
- No prior authorization required for T2D indication with most Part D plans

MEDICARE ADVANTAGE

Unlike Wegovy (which Medicare generally does NOT cover for weight loss), Rybelsus is routinely covered because it is a diabetes medication. If you have T2D and want semaglutide on Medicare, Rybelsus may be your most accessible and affordable option.

6 NEW: RYBELSUS R2 FORMULATION (APPROVED DEC 2024)

In December 2024, the FDA approved the **Rybelsus R2 formulation**, which uses a new co-formulated absorption enhancer to improve oral bioavailability. This is an important development that may affect your cost and treatment decisions.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR YOUR WALLET

The R2 formulation offers higher doses (25 mg, 50 mg) with better absorption. If pricing is similar to R1, the Savings Card should still bring your cost to ~\$10/fill. Ask your provider if the R2 formulation is right for you — it may offer better efficacy at a similar cost, potentially making Rybelsus more competitive with injectable options.

7 ADDITIONAL COST-SAVING STRATEGIES

A. Compare Pharmacy Prices

Rybelsus prices can vary significantly between pharmacies. Always compare before filling your prescription.

- Use GoodRx.com or RxSaver.com to compare local pharmacy prices
- Check Costco Pharmacy (no membership required for Rx in most states)
- Consider mail-order pharmacies for potential 90-day supply discounts
- Ask about independent pharmacy pricing — sometimes lower than chains

B. Insurance Optimization

If your current plan does not cover Rybelsus or places it on a high tier, consider these strategies.

- During Open Enrollment: compare plans specifically for GLP-1 drug coverage
- Request a formulary exception from your insurer (with Letter of Medical Necessity)
- Ask your provider to submit a prior authorization if required
- Check if your plan covers Rybelsus at a lower tier than Ozempic (common for oral vs injectable)

C. Dose Optimization

Work with your provider to ensure you are on the most cost-effective dose for your clinical needs.

- Rybelsus 3 mg, 7 mg, and 14 mg are often priced the same per fill
- Do NOT split tablets — Rybelsus must be swallowed whole
- If 7 mg provides adequate control, staying at this dose saves nothing on cost but avoids unnecessary dose escalation

- NeedyMeds.org — database of patient assistance programs

- RxAssist.org — comprehensive directory of pharmaceutical assistance
- State Pharmaceutical Assistance Programs (SPAPs) — varies by state
- Patient Advocate Foundation (PAF) — free case management for coverage issues
- American Diabetes Association — resources for medication access

9 RYBELSUS DOSING SCHEDULE & COST TIMELINE

Rybelsus uses a dose-escalation schedule to minimize gastrointestinal side effects. Understanding this timeline helps you plan your costs and savings card usage.

IMPORTANT: TAKING RYBELSUS CORRECTLY

- Take on an empty stomach with no more than 4 oz (120 mL) of plain water.
- Wait at least 30 minutes before eating, drinking, or taking other oral medications.
- Swallow the tablet whole — do NOT crush, chew, or split.
- The R2 formulation may have reduced fasting requirements — confirm with your provider.
